Minutes of Regular Meeting Mayor and Council City of Fitzgerald, Georgia January 8, 2018 6:00 pm

A Public Hearing took place at the City Hall Council Chambers, located at 302 East Central Avenue, on Monday, January 8, 2018.

A Public Hearing was held to consider AK Star, LLC, applying for a City of Fitzgerald Revolving Loan Fund for up to \$40,000.00. This application was properly advertised. Mayor Massee asked if anyone would like to speak regarding this application. With no comments, the public hearing was closed.

Mayor and Council of the City of Fitzgerald, Georgia, met in a *Regular* meeting immediately following the Public Hearing with Mayor Massee presiding and with Council members Coney, Griffin, Holt, Jefferson, Jones, Roberts, Tillman, Webb and Williams being present.

Minutes of December 18, 2017, Regular Council meeting were read. Mayor Massee entertained a motion for approval. Council Person Coney made a motion to approve minutes, seconded by Council Person Williams. Having a motion and a second, Mayor Massee asked if there were any other additions or corrections. With none being heard, called for a **Roll Call Vote: 9 Yes, 0 No. All in favor, motion approved.**

Mayor Massee opened with appreciation for those in attendance. Mayor Massee recognized the full chamber of visitors, family members and frequent guests. Council Person Coney motioned to dispense with full reading, seconded by Council Person Williams. Mayor Massee asked if there was any discussion and with none called for *Roll Call Vote:* 9 Yes, 0 No. All in favor, motion approved.

Mayor Massee asked for approval of *Resolution R18-001*. Council Person Holt motioned to approve *Resolution R18-001*, seconded by Council Person Coney. Mayor Massee asked if there was any discussion and with none called for *Roll Call Vote: 9 Yes, 0 No. All in favor, motion approved.*

Under new business, Mayor Massee asked for consideration to approve the RLF loan to AK Star, LLC. This application was considered by the RLF committee and also the public hearing. Council Person Webb motioned to approve the RLF loan to AK Star, LLC, seconded by Council Person Coney. Mayor Massee asked if there was any discussion and with none heard called for Roll Call Vote: 9 Yes, 0 No. All in favor, motion approved.
